SCHOOL YEAR

The 2021 AP Exams will be administered over two weeks in May: May 4 through 7 and May 10 through 14. The College Board has made significant changes to the exam registration timeline, as well as added several fees for late exam registrations. Please note the important dates below. If you have questions that are not answered here, please contact your school's Associate Principal of Curriculum and Instruction.

PER EXAM FEE

\$95 for the regularly priced exam \$5 for students who qualify for reduced fee

FEE PAYMENTSCHEDULE*

Students may pay in full or pay in installments to help families spread out the cost of exams. Full payment or first installment for all exams is due **November 1, 2020**. Payment must be received by this date to register for AP exams.

If paying in installments:

a. 11/1/20 1st installment due \$40 per exam (\$55 remaining)
b. 1/30/21 2nd installment due \$30 per exam (\$25 remaining)

c. 2/28/21 3rd installment due \$25 per exam (\$0 remaining)

EXAMPLE

STUDENT 1: REGULAR FEES

Taking AP Calculus AB and AP Government Exams November 1 - Initial registration payment of \$80 January 30 - Paid \$60 more for a total of \$140 February 28 - Paid \$50 more for a total of \$190

STUDENT 2: Reduced Fee

Taking AP Calculus AB and AP Government Exams November 1 - Initial registration payment of \$10 No further payments due

EXTRA FEES

LATE REGISTRATION FEE - \$40 PER EXAM

Any registration of a student after November 1 will be charged this fee.
