Together, the School Site Council focuses on all student needs and the mission and vision of Gregori High School through analyzing data and student outcomes to ensure the success of our students. The council meets 5-6 times per school year at a time mutually decided upon to meet the needs of its members as a whole. The Gregori School Site Council (SSC) is an integral and important council for our school community. What exactly is the purpose of a School Site Council? School Site Council is designed to develop and revise the Single Plan for Student Achievement. This plan defines and outlines a guide that helps Gregori High School meet the academic and social needs of our students. School Site Council may help to make decisions regarding school funds allocated to increase student achievement.

The School Site Council is comprised of five parents or community members who are nominated and elected by Gregori High School parents.

The School Site Council also is represented by the school principal, three teachers, and one other staff member. Meetings are held every month or every other month depending on the need and last for one hour.
